

Course Selection 2018 – LCVI – MyBlueprint

February 12-28th!

Getting Ready: *How do I get ready to select my courses for next semester?*

- Each day between February 12th – 16th, Student Services staff will be visiting period one classes to help you get ready!
- Look at the bottom of your **Credit Counselling Summary Sheet** to see the credits you have completed from the credits required to graduate.
 - Remember: you also have credits “in progress” (going to be completed this year in Semester 2)
- **Consider your pathway:**
 - Apprenticeship, College, University or Workplace.
 - What are the admission requirements for your chosen program after high school?
- Consult the **Course Selection Book 2018-2019** to get more information about courses you are considering.
 - All course information is available right in MyBlueprint when selecting your courses, or by clicking on “Course Calendar” at the top right of the course selection page in MyBlueprint.
 - The [course selection book 2018-1019](#) can also be found as a PDF on the LCVI school website under the “Student Services” drop down menu.
- **Special Programs!**
 - Students moving into grade 11 or 12 next year may consider:
 - **Focus Programs** – Allow students to earn both compulsory and elective courses in a bundled set of courses.
 - **Dual Credits** and **SWAC** – specialized programs at St. Lawrence College.
 - **SHSM** Certification (Specialist High-Skills Major)
 - **OYAP** – construction and apprenticeship.

- **Talk to your parents/guardians and teachers** if you have questions, or come down to **student services** if you need more advice.

Completing your Course Selection: *(Using MyBlueprint!)*

1. Use your web browser to navigate to **myblueprint.ca/limestone**
2. Click on (Log In) or (Sign Up) and follow the instructions
 - Activation Key: **loyalistcvi**
 - Create your account using your OEN or login to your myblueprint account.
 - OEN#s can be found on your timetable, credit counselling summary or report card)
 - **Select LCVI from the school drop down menu** to start.
3. Click on the “**Highschool**” tab of the main menu on the left hand side of the screen.
 - the “**Plan**” tab should be selected automatically in the High School screen and you can click it later to get back to your course selection plan.

Completing your Course Selection Continued

4. You will select **8** courses for next year. (Grade 11/12 are allowed one spare)
 - **COMPULSORY courses** – required courses that all students must complete.
 - **ELECTIVE courses** – Optional courses you can choose depending in your personal interests and academic focus.

5. Your **COMPULSORY courses** for next year (English, Math, Careers, Etc.) are listed specifically in the options. Clicking on a compulsory course will take you to a shortened list of options for that course.
 - Clicking on a specific course will open up a description of the course so you can know exactly what you are selecting.

6. Your **ELECTIVE courses**, (labelled “Course” in the list) will require you to search through the larger list of available courses to find a course that you would like to take. **Be aware of prerequisites.** (Ex. *you can't take grade 11 university math until you have completed grade 10 academic math.*)
 - **Popular choices** for elective courses include:
 - **Hospitality Lunch Class** (under “Technological Education”)
 - **Choir / Band / Photography / Guitar** (MANY options under “Art”)
 - **Law / Politics / History** (under “Canadian and World Studies”)
 - **Gender Studies / Nutrition and Health / World Religions / Personal Life Management** (under “Social Studies and Humanities”)
 - **Peer Tutoring** (GPP30 – under “Guidance and Career Education”)
 - **Coop** (Grade 11/12 - under “Cooperative Education”)
 - **Leadership** (11/12 – under “Interdisciplinary Studies”)
 - **Remember you can ask for assistance from student services if you have questions or would like advice about your course options.**

7. Once you have selected all your courses, click the blue **“Review Course Selection”** button (upper right area of the screen)

8. Click on **“Submit Your Courses”**

9. Click on **“Print Sign-Off Sheet”** and have the sheet **SIGNED** by your parent/guardian

10. **Return the signed sheet**
 - Selections are due to Student Services **BEFORE Feb 28**
 - If you can't print off your MyBlueprint confirmation sheet, you can circle your selections on the **LCVI Course Selection Sheet 2018-2019** (available in student services) and have your parent or guardian sign that sheet and bring it in.
